
The Hop On Facility allows for legal entities from low R&I performing countries to join already selected collaborative R&I actions, subject to the agreement of the respective consortium and provided that legal entities from such countries are not yet participating in it. The scheme aims to improve the inclusiveness ... Horizon Europe by involving more research institutions from Widening countries under Horizon Europe Pillar 2 and EIC Pathfinder actions.

Main selection criteria are excellence and added value of the new partner performing a relevant additional task in the project. All consortium partners need to agree on the accession of the new partner whereas the R&I relevance and complementarity needs to be demonstrated. The accepted application will trigger a G... amendment with the service in charge of the related topic.

Project results are expected to contribute to the following expected outcomes:

 At system level, it mobilises excellence in the Widening countries, increases visibility of the participants from the Widening countries, improves knowledge circulation, and reduces lack of participation of the Widening countries in specific thematic domains;



We support interregional cooperation projects.

Our projects bring together policy organisations from at least three different countries in the 27 EU member states, Norway and Switzerland. For four years, they learn from each other and work together on a shared policy issue.

The lessons they learn lead to better regional policies and a more sustainable economic, social and environmental impact on the ground for the people and the places they serve.

Our topics

We support projects in five thematic EU priorities and one nonthematic issue on better governance:

- Smart
- Green
- Connected
- Social
- Citizens
- Governance

We aim to improve regional policies through capacity building in all of these topics.

The Creative Europe programme 2021-2027 has a budget of € 2.44 billion, compared to €1.47 billion of the previous programme (2014-2020). Creative Europe invests in actions that reinforce cultural diversity and respond to the needs and challenges of the cultural and creative sectors.

The main objectives of the programme are to

- safeguard, develop and promote European cultural and linguistic diversity and heritage
- increase the competitiveness and economic potential of the cultural and creative sectors, in particular the audiovisual sector

The novelties of the programme will contribute to the recovery of these sectors, reinforcing their efforts to become more inclusive, more digital and environmentally more sustainable.

The Creative Europe programme is divided in 3 **strands**.

Creative Europe



Novelties of the Creative Europe programme

The main novelties of the programme are

- stronger emphasis on transnational creation and on innovation
- easier access to funding through higher co-financing rates (greater contribution levels from Creative Europe for projects)
- emphasis on supporting EU-level cooperation to make the European audiovisual sector more globally competitive
- mobility scheme for artists and professionals
- actions that target the needs of specific creative sectors, such as music, architecture, and cultural heritage


