This will include a focus placed on the relations between the work plan thematic areas and relevant IUCN resolutions from the latest World Conservation Congress. IUCN members from all regions (including East Europe and North Africa) are welcome to join this discussion. The outcomes are expected to enhance ownership of the IUCN Nature 2030 Programme, respond to IUCN's Europe commitment to monitor the implementation and actions in the region, and support an increased coordination of IUCN action in the region overall.
